### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The purpose of the Melrose Manors Project, part of the City of Fort Lauderdale's WaterWorks 2011 program, is to extend sanitary sewer service to an area of the City that is currently unsewered and uses septic tanks for disposal of residential and commercial sewage. The city is undertaking this work because even though septic tanks can work well for a long time, they will eventually have unacceptable impacts upon groundwater and adjacent surface water, particularly in urban areas.

This project consists of the installation of a gravity sewer system throughout the entire Melrose Manors neighborhood, and when completed, will have over 1,000 properties connected to the system.

### SCOPE OF WORK

Installation of a central gravity sanitary sewer system including nearly 20,000 LF of gravity sanitary line, force main, water main, and over 200 sewer connections.
